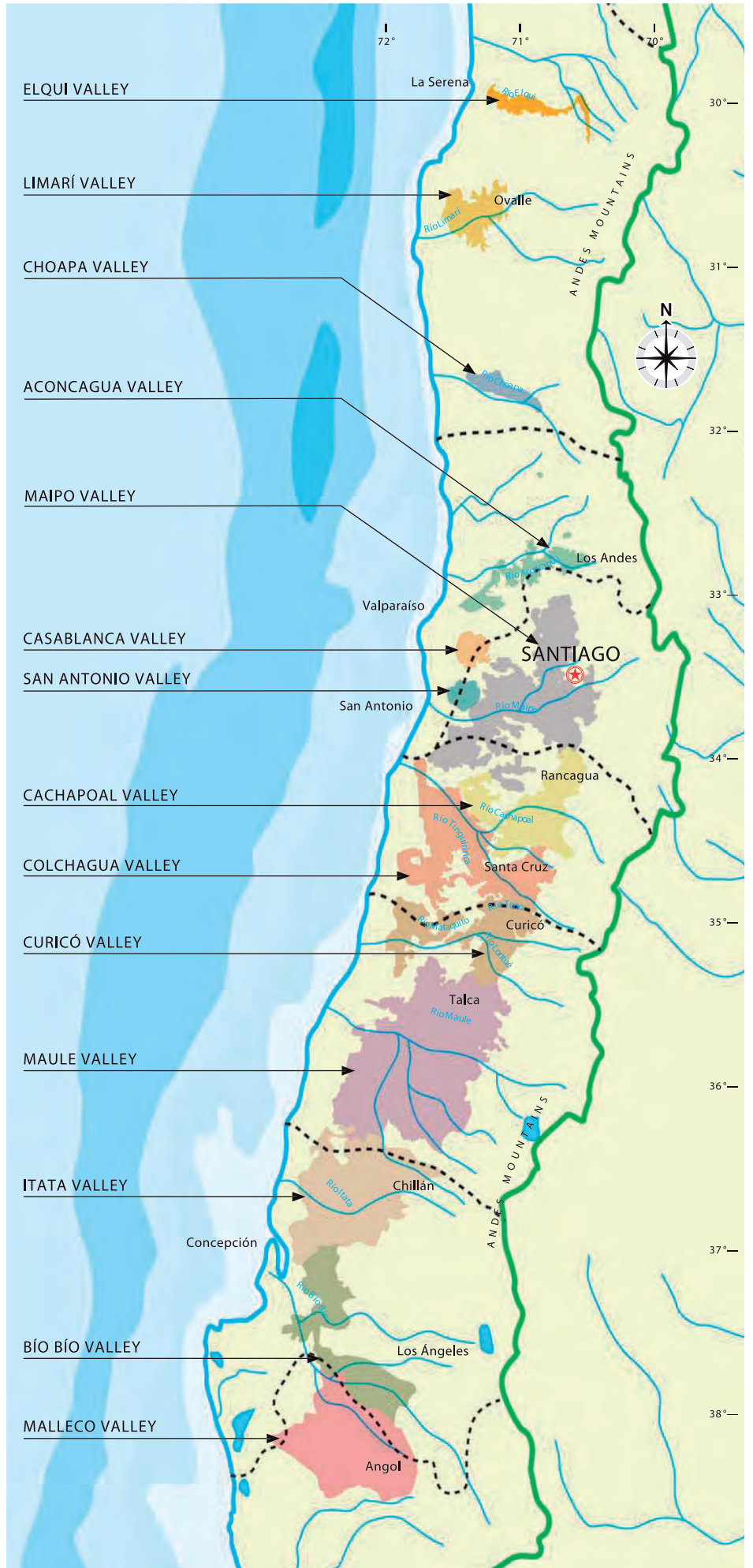


Chilean Wine Regions

Four hundred-fifty years ago Spanish settlers found Chile to be a winemaker's paradise.

This long, thin country has diverse geography: the Atacama Desert, the Andes Mountains, the Pacific Ocean and Antarctica. In the centre, more than 112,000 hectares of high-quality wine grapes benefit from sunny days, cool nights, a Mediterranean climate, diverse soil types and talented winemakers: everything needed to produce a wide range of excellent wines.

The traditional home of Chilean wine is the large expanse of fertile flatland in the centre of the country known as the "Central Valley," where grapes grow well and ripen easily. Today's search for terroir has led winemakers to experiment with new varieties and seek out new and generally cooler places to plant them. Central Valley growers climb into the Andean foothills, and others move west toward the Pacific, north to the semi-arid mountainous regions and southward to the country's austral agricultural extremes. The result is greater diversity and a large selection of exciting wines from Chile.

Foreign investment is attracted by Chile's business-friendly conditions and political stability, whilst the exports of copper, fresh fruit, salmon, and of course wine, give Chile international prestige.

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Viña El Principal is situated in the Maipo Valley, on a suggestive foothill environment, close to the country's capital city (Santiago). Its vineyards climb above 900 meters above sea level.

The Maipo Valley, where the temperature oscillates greatly, is breathed upon by the fresh winds from the Andes Mountains. The product is distinguished wines, specially the cabernet sauvignon, a strain quite fixed to this valley, which is a terroir that produces the best red wines in South America.

The vinification process starts with the harvest, which is done completely by hand. Then it comes the selection of the grape bunches and berries, also by hand, on sorting tables, which feed the carefully selected grapes into the destemmer. Finally, the wine is transferred and filled, by gravity, into french oak barrels.

Also, we are working with from harvest 2006 with the renowned French consultant Patrick Leon who work with the Chief winemaker Gonzalo

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Viña Falernia was founded in 1997 by Aldo Olivier Gramola and his cousin, Giorgio Flessati, a seasoned winemaker from the Trentino region in Northern Italy. Located in the Elqui Valley, between La Serena and Vicuña, 470km to the north of Santiago, its 320 hectares are spread over three vineyard sites, and are Chile's northernmost wine estate.

Titon vineyard produces the superb Sauvignon Blanc, with mineral quality, and the award winning Syrah Reservado, and lies at an altitude of 350m, about 20km inland. The second vineyard site lies at 500m above sea level, surrounding the new winery, 40km inland and next to the Puclaro Dam where it is substantially drier. The third vineyard is called Huenta and at 2000m, will qualify as one of the highest vineyards in the world.

The brand new winery is completely insulated and equipped with state of the art technology. Underground cellars for barrel ageing (French and American) complete the s
